

Answers

1. 4

The vulture, the owl, the robin and the bee can all fly. That's 4 animals!

2. 2

The fox and the cat both have fur. That's 2 animals.

3. 5

Cats are fluffy, jellyfish are not. There are 5 cats.

4. 4

Jellyfish are blue, cats are not. There are 4 jellyfish.

5. 2

The jellyfish and the crocodile like living in the water. It's still okay if you didn't count the crocodile.

6. 7

The dog, the fox, the giraffe, the lion, the bee, the cat and the elephant all like living on land. It's still okay if you counted the crocodile or if you didn't count the bee!

7. 4

Lions roar. Count the lions 1.. 2.. 3.. 4..

8. 2

Herbivores are animals that eat grass and plants, but not meat. Elephants are herbivores. Count them!

9. 2

The whale and the jellyfish like living in the ocean.

10. 3

The vulture, owl and robin have all got feathers because they are all birds!

The giraffe, fox, lion and elephant each have 4 legs.
